### 1. Early Years Plan

Jeannette Laursoo, Director of Instruction, Sheri Brattston, Coordinator of Community Services and Early Learning, and Angela Meredith, Early Learning Helping Teacher provided the committee with an overview of the District Early Years Plan.

During the 2018-19 school year, over 30 educators, including Elementary Principals, StrongStart Educators, Primary Teachers and district staff worked collaboratively with consultant John Talbot on the dl lao(l)-2p(l)-2m-6 (a2(t)-6 (-Qtr(d)Te)Q(y( \$(tdl)t)t-2embry (isonsectorative) Kindergarten, but there is an opportunity for students to enrol at the beginning of grade Erench Immersion begins in grade 6 and students continue in the program joining early immersion peers from gradgrrgrhgrade

Registration procedures and placement priorities for our language programs were highlighted for the committee. Enrolment history demonstrates that the program has more than doubled in size since 2000/2001 and the ten year projected enrolment shows that we continue to maintain current enrolment numbers. In order to accommodate the high demand for our Immersion Programs, the District is maximizing space within schools to sustain the current level of access.
